The fact that we have this new surface as we begin the Autumn Term is an incredible achievement, given we only made the decision to make this project our priority, at Easter. I would like to thank the tremendous support of the entire school community; an incredible £116,000 was raised in a relatively short time. If you bought an ice cream during the Summer Term, contributed to the Nearly New Sale or supported any of the PTA events this year, we very much appreciate your contribution.

There are also a number of individuals and organisations who contributed to this project directly, including substantial donations from parents and friends of the school, Oxfordshire County Council, Oxford City Council, Jericho Café, Carter Jonas, Savills, Summerfield's, Kumon, Phil & Jim School and of course Summertown Stars Football Club.

A great deal of effort went on behind the scenes, with many people working over and above on this project and I would like to formally thank them for their hard work and support. Beccy Ekins, Carrie Hayward, Ruth Dorso and Emma Dadson all contributed a great deal of their time and energy. I would also like express my gratitude to Sarah Griffiths who has been a key driving force behind this project. Sarah has worked tirelessly to ensure we had funds to replace the surface, a project of this scale would not have been possible without her enthusiasm and we are incredibly grateful for all she has done.


