- practice blending and segmenting the new sound in cvc

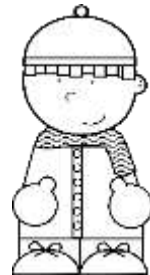
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For Show and Tell on **Wednesday** – children are invited to bring in an object that begins with either **p, n, s** or **i**.
