
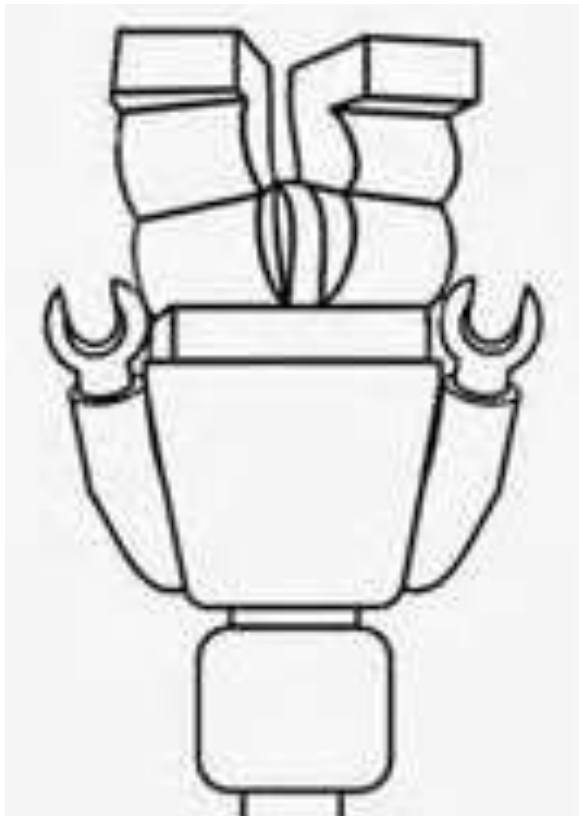
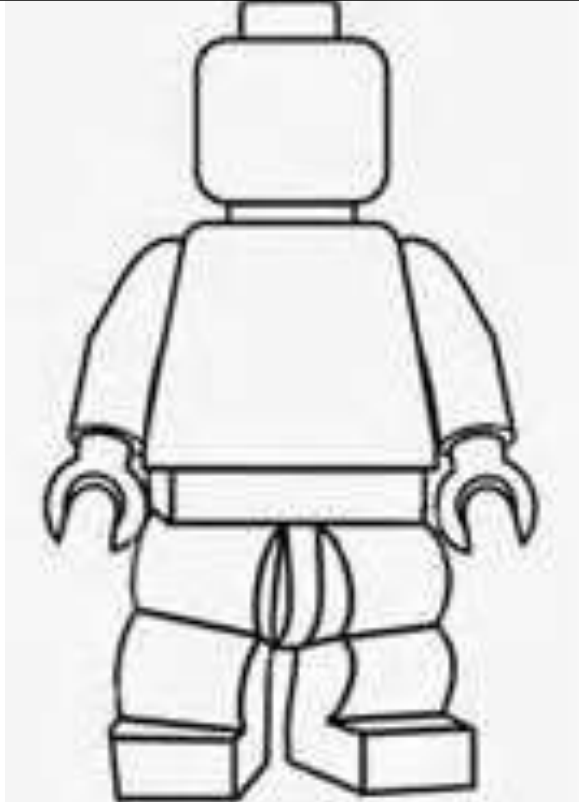


<p>modal verbs</p>		<p>Verbs that show possibility: would, could, should, might, will, can.</p>	
<p>synonym</p>		<p>A word with the exact same meaning as another word. clever = wise</p>	
<p>relative clause</p>		<p>add more detail to a noun. The boy, who was 11, smiled. My house is near school, which is convenient.</p>	
<p>possessive pronoun</p>		<p>mine, yours, hers, theirs, his, ours</p>	
<p>subject pronoun</p>		<p>I, he, she, it, you, we, they</p>	
<p>object pronoun</p>		<p>me, him, her, them, it, us</p>	
<p>past progressive tense</p>		<p>was/were + _ing I was washing. You were thinking.</p>	
<p>past simple tense</p>		<p>Regular verbs end in _ed I cooked, I cleaned. Many irregular verbs. I thought. I wrote.</p>
