Dear Parents,

As we approach Christmas, we thought it would be an ideal time to send out the kit list for PGL in the hope that you might be able to make use of the sales in shops to start collecting items your child will need.

Things that you will need to bring:

Sleeping bag or duvet

Pillow (optional, but these are not provided by PGL)

Old clothes - a mix of long and short sleeve t-shirts that you do not mind getting very muddy and wet (at least two of each)

2 Jumpers (it can be very cold when you are playing outside in the evening)

2/3 sets of clothes for the evenings

Four pairs of trousers (these need to dry easily – no jeans please)

5/6 pairs of socks and pants (socks need to cover ankles - no trainer socks please)

Plastic bag for wet clothes

Plastic bag for dirty clothes

Two pairs of trainers or outdoor shoes (one pair **will** be used for a wet activity and therefore will not be able to be worn after this)

Waterproof jacket*

Gloves and hat (in case it's cold)*

Sun cream, sun hat (in case it's sunny)*

Pyjamas or other suitable night clothes

Toothbrush

Toothpaste

Hair brush

Shampoo (and conditioner if required)

Shower gel/soap

Disposable camera (if required)

One soft toy (if required)

Paper, pen, stamped addressed envelope

2 towels

Something to read*

Please note that deodorant, if brought, needs to be roll-on due to the sensitive nature of the fire and smoke alarms at Beam House.
