Next week

We will be entering the world of magic beans and giants - using the story of Jack and The Beanstalk.

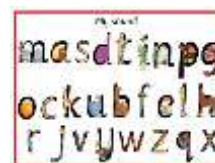


In PSED: We will be thinking about how we can solve problems by talking and listening to our friends.

In Maths: We will be using money to buy beans, measuring beanstalks, giant foot prints, and estimating how many objects we can see and then checking by counting them.

In Literacy: We will be retelling the story of Jack and the beanstalk using talk for writing to help us draw story maps and write sentences.

In Phonics: The children now know all of set 1 phonemes



Many children will know or recognise some of the set 2 and will be able to use them in their reading and writing.

In Understanding the World: We will be looking at different types of beans, how they grow and where they may come from in the world.
